- 5. Why do you think Paul says "love" binds all of the virtues together in perfect unity? What other passage of scriptures validate this statement?
- 6. Reflect on your relationship with Christ. How do your relationships with others reflect the ongoing maturity of Christ in your life?
- 7. What, if anything, is holding you back from becoming more mature in Christ?
