2 Timothy 2:15

Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.

2 Timothy 2:16-17

But avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness, and their talk will spread like gangrene.

2 Timothy 2:17-18

Among them are Hymenaeus and Philetus, who have swerved from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already happened.

2 Timothy 2:18-19

They are upsetting the faith of some. But God's firm foundation stands, bearing this seal: "The Lord knows those who are his," and, "Let everyone who names the name of the Lord depart from iniquity."

The kings of the earth will bring their splendor into it, (and) the glory and honor of the nations will be brought into it.


(But) nothing impure will ever enter it...only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.
