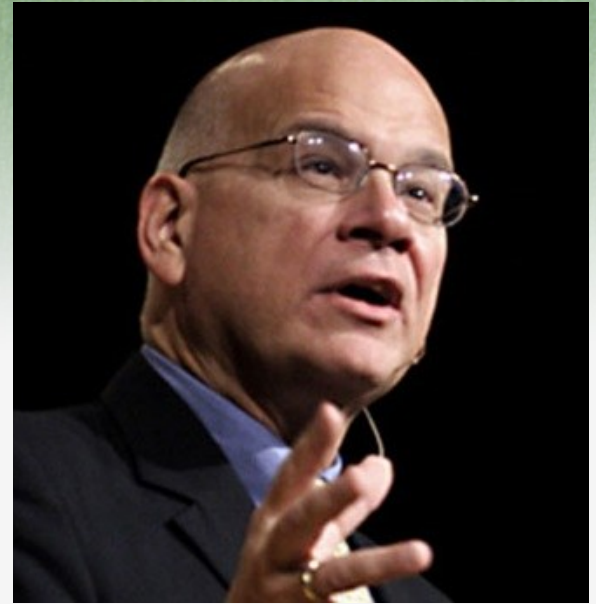

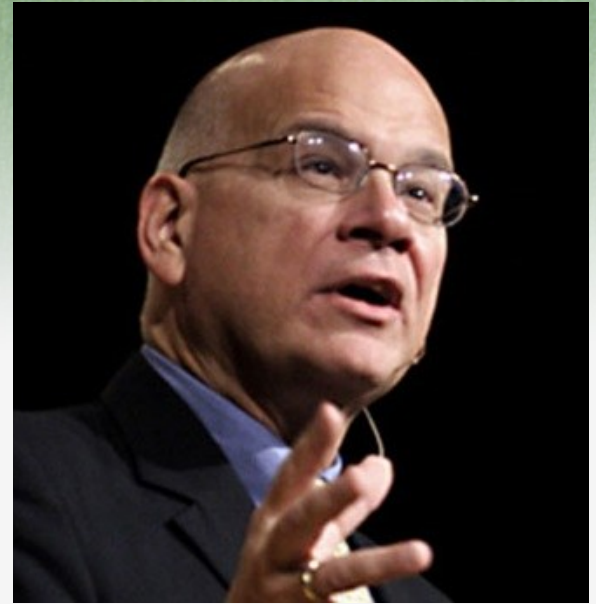
Sometimes we need to do things just because God says so...
