Life Group Message Discussion Questions

1 Peter 1:10-13

1. What are some things in your life that you tend to take for granted? Why do you think that is? How does taking those things for granted impact your perspective whenever you go through difficult times? How does it impact your faith and ability to trust in God?
2. Read 1 Peter 1:10-13. What specific reasons does this passage give for why we should never lose our awe and gratitude for the gift of salvation?
3. According to this passage, who knows more about the work and person of Christ, the Old Testament prophets or us? What does this passage say that God had in mind when He spoke to prophets in the past?
4. In what ways were the Old Testament prophecies about Jesus similar to separate pieces of a larger puzzle? Did the prophets understand how their particular “pieces” fit in with the bigger picture about who the Messiah would be? Why or why not?
5. Peter mentions those “who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit” (v. 12). Who are some of those individuals whom God used to lead you to make a decision to follow Christ?
6. What part does this passage say that the Holy Spirit plays in the process of salvation?
7. According to v. 12, how do angels figure into the salvation that God has in store for His children? What do we get to experience as humans that angels do not?
8. If you are a Christ-follower, is your salvation truly the greatest thing in your life? Is it something that fills you each day with “an inexpressible and glorious joy” (v. 9)? If not, why not?
