Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery. **Gal 5:13a** - You, my brothers, were called to be free. 1. _____ in the face of _____ Gal 5:2-4,9 - Mark my words! I, Paul, tell you that if you let yourselves be circumcised, Christ will be of no value to you at all. ³ Again I declare to every man who lets himself be circumcised that he is obligated to obey the whole law. ⁴ You who are trying to be justified by law have been alienated from Christ; you have fallen away from grace. 9 "A little yeast works through the whole batch of dough." 2. _____ in the face of ____ **Gal 5:5-6,10** - But by faith we eagerly await through the Spirit the righteousness for which we hope. ⁶ For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision has any value. The only thing that counts is faith expressing itself through love. ¹⁰ I am confident in the Lord that you will take no other view. The one who is throwing you into confusion will pay the penalty, whoever he may be. 3. _____ in the face of _____ **Gal 5:7-8,11-12** – You were running a good race. Who cut in on you and kept you from obeying the truth? ⁸ That kind of persuasion does not come from the one who calls you. ¹¹ Brothers, if I am still preaching circumcision, why am I still being persecuted? In that case the offense of the cross has been abolished. 12 As for those agitators, I wish they would

go the whole way and emasculate themselves!
