Psalm 139:13-16 –

you knit me together in my mother's womb.
- ¹⁴ I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made;
your works are wonderful,
I know that full well.
- ¹⁵ My frame was not hidden from you
when I was made in the secret place,
when I was woven together in the depths of the earth.
- ¹⁶ Your eyes saw my unformed body;
all the days ordained for me were written in your book
before one of them came to be.

Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Psalm 139:13-16

1. What is encouraging and what is challenging about all our days being written in God's book before one of them came to be? (Psalm 139:16)
2. Do you typically hear expecting mothers refer to the life in their womb as a "baby" or something else? Why do you think that is?
3. What typically helps most in dealing with shame from our pasts? Trying to forget it? Talking about it? Something else?
4. When you think of the "voiceless," who comes to mind?
5. Do you most often find yourself giving a voice to those who don't have one or staying quiet? Why?
6. What is one way you could use your voice to speak for babies in the womb?
