

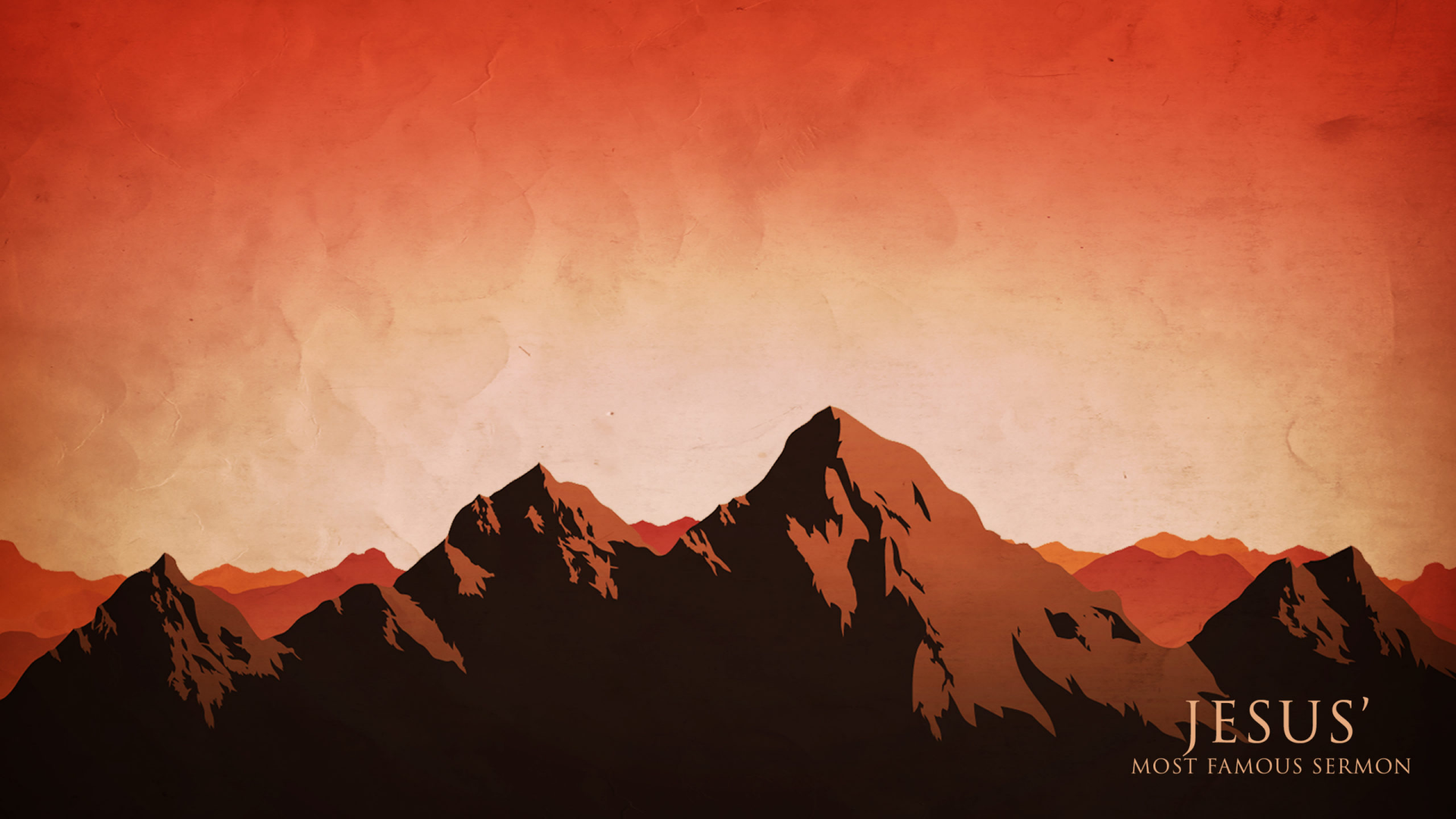

the tax collectors do the same?

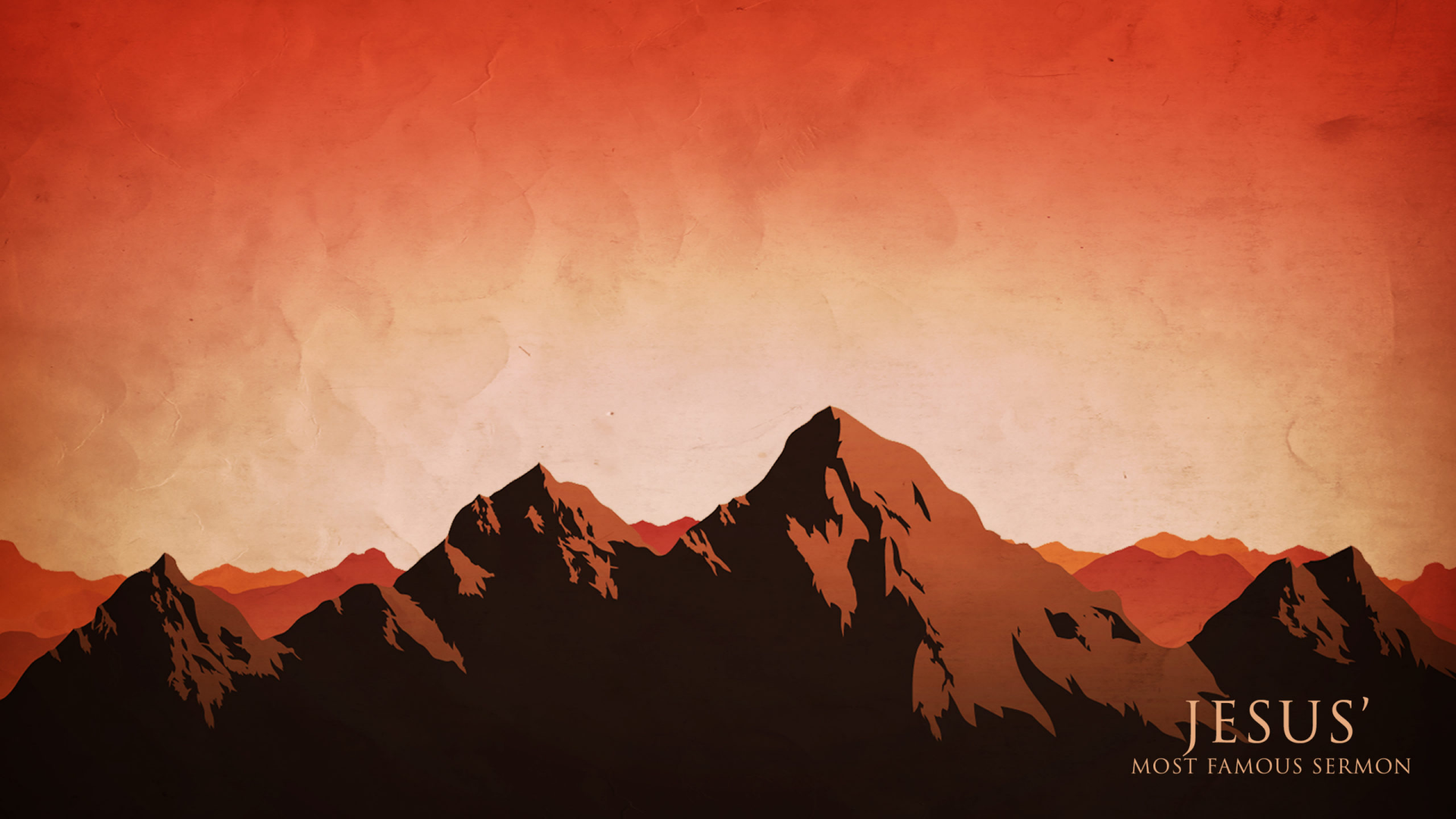
## Matthew 5:38-48

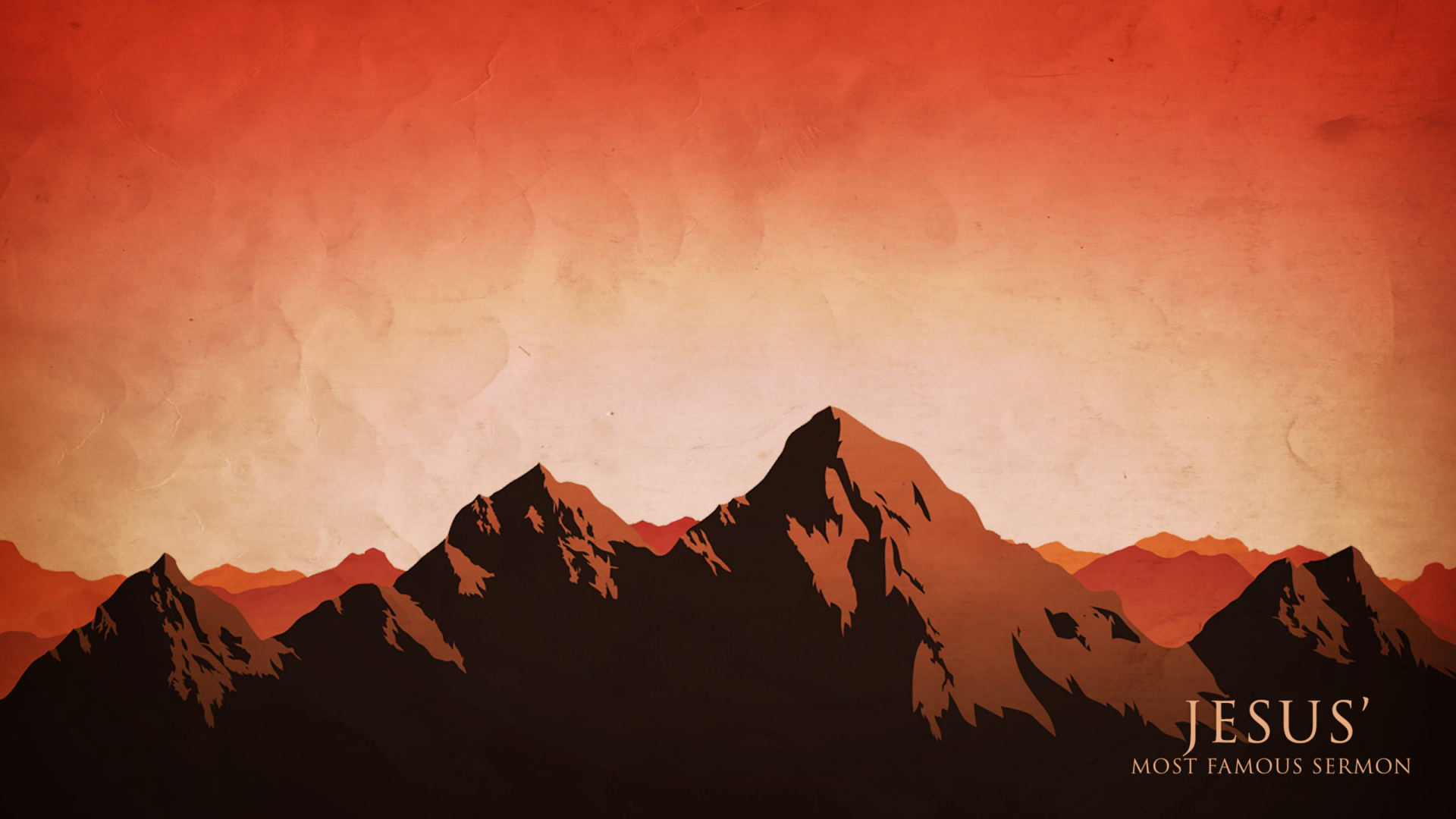
<sup>48</sup> You therefore must be perfect,
