Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Job 1:18-22

- 1. When have you seen (or heard of) someone responding to suffering with trust in God or even worship of God? Think of friends, historical figures, or songwriters.
- 2. What was your reaction to how they trusted in God in the midst of their suffering?
- 3. What do you think enabled them to respond the way that they did?
- 4. What is difficult about trusting a God who could have stopped a tragedy but didn't? At the same time, how does trusting in God (who didn't prevent the tragedy) help us to process the tragedy?
- 5. What role has sorrow ever played in your worship? Do you usually feel free to tell God exactly how upset you are, or do you usually feel you must only speak with Him if you are calm, cool, and collected? Why?
- 6. Are there any frustrations you haven't aired with God? What's preventing you from doing so?
