Questions for Reflection and DiscussionPsalm 96

- 1. How much of a role do you believe that singing praises to God play in both your private spiritual life and your corporate spiritual life?
- 2. What connections have you noticed between singing to God and experiencing God? Which comes first, singing to God or experiencing God?
- 3. Have you ever felt timid to sing praises to God? When? Why?
- 4. What do you tend to praise most often: who God is, what He has done, or what He will do? Least often? Why do you think that is?
- 5. David wrote Psalm 96 when the Ark, symbolizing God's presence, returned to Jerusalem. Why is God's presence, even if nothing else changes, worth celebrating?
- 6. David praises God for creation and redemption. Have either of those works of God ever become stale to you? What typically refreshes their wonder in your heart?
- 7. David praises God for His future rule and judgment of the earth. When have you seen evil or wickedness ousted from a family, organization, or business and good leadership reinstituted? Did you celebrate it? Why?
