Psalm 96

3. Have you ever felt timid to sing praises to God? When? Why?
4. What do you tend to praise most often: who God is, what He has done, or what He will do? Least often? Why do you think that is?
5. David wrote Psalm 96 when the Ark, symbolizing God's presence, returned to Jerusalem. Why is God's presence, even if nothing else changes, worth celebrating?
6. David praises God for creation and redemption. Have either of those works of God ever become stale to you? What typically refreshes their wonder in your heart?
7. David praises God for His future rule and judgment of the earth. When have you seen evil or wickedness ousted from a family, organization, or business and good leadership reinstated? Did you celebrate it? Why?
