Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Exodus 12:21-32

1. What parts of the Passover story are most comforting to you? Which parts are most unsettling?
2. What do you believe God is communicating to you through both the comforting and unsettling parts of the story?
3. What do you believe would be the most effective means to communicate to our current culture that everyone owes a debt to God because of our sin?
4. If everyone owes the same spiritual debt, is anyone spiritually superior to anyone else? Why or why not?
5. Whom (or what group) do you find yourself most often judging as spiritually inferior? Why?
6. If the early Jewish Christians ceased celebrating Passover because they understood Jesus to be the true Passover Lamb and communion to be the ongoing reminder of the true Passover, how should our view of communion change? Our view of Passover?
7. What, if anything, would change in your life if you believed your debt before God was totally, completely, fully and forever paid by God Himself? Would you pray more or less? Would you give away more or less? Would you live a holier life or a less holy life? Would you worry more or less? Why?
