³ "For twenty-three years, from the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah, to this day,

the word of the Lord has come to me, and I have spoken persistently to you, but you have not listened.

⁴ You have neither listened nor inclined your ears to hear, although the Lord persistently sent to you all his servants the prophets,

⁵ saying, 'Turn now, every one of you, from his evil way and evil deeds, and dwell upon the land that the Lord has given to you and your fathers from of old and forever.

⁷ Yet you have not listened to me, declares the Lord, that you might provoke me to anger with the work of your hands to your own harm.

¹⁵ Thus the Lord, the God of Israel, said to me: "Take from my hand this cup of the wine of wrath, and make all the nations to whom I send you drink it.

¹⁶ They shall drink and stagger and be crazed because of the sword that I am sending among them."

²⁸ "And if they refuse to accept the cup from your hand to drink, then you shall say to them, 'Thus says the Lord of hosts: You must drink!

²⁹ For behold, I begin to work disaster at the city that is called by my name, and shall you go unpunished?

You shall not go unpunished, for I am summoning a sword against all the inhabitants of the earth, declares the Lord of hosts.'

³⁴ "Wail, you shepherds, and cry out, and roll in ashes, you lords of the flock, for the days of your slaughter and dispersion have come, and you shall fall like a choice vessel.

No refuge will remain for the shepherds, nor escape for the lords of the flock.
 A voice—the cry of the shepherds, and the wail of the lords of the flock!

For the Lord is laying waste their pasture, ³⁷ and the peaceful folds are devastated because of the fierce anger of the Lord.
