Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Mark 1:1-20

1. When you read the Bible, do you typically assume it's primarily about what you must do or primarily about what God has done? Why? What difference would it make?
2. As early as verse 1, Mark states his account is about God coming to earth. Why might some people find such an event comforting while other people find it threatening?
3. If Jesus were walking around on the earth today doing what He did in the 1st century, how do you think people would respond?
4. How would you respond? Is it the same as how you respond to Him today? Why or why not?
5. In the past, when you have realized that you are only willing to follow or be associated with Jesus to the extent that it won't interfere with your reputation, career, comfort, relationships, etc, what has helped you let go of those things?
6. What did you find on the other side of letting go? Joy? Regret? Something else?
7. Is there anything you hear Jesus calling you to let go of today?
