Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Ephesians 5:15-21

- 1. Is there anything that inspires you to want to burst out in song? Maybe a trip to the beach or the mountains? Maybe a fond memory? Or maybe you're the type of person who has a constant soundtrack in your head and you just randomly burst into song all the time. What makes you sing?

- 3. In what ways do you feel held back or restrained from singing more freely or boldly, both individually and corporately?
- 4. Have you ever had a time when you didn't feel like singing in a worship gathering? Were you able to overcome it? If so, how?
- 5. Hebrews 13:15 says, "Through Him then let us continually offer up a sacrifice of praise..." In what ways is your worship "sacrificial?"
- 6. Romans 12:1 says that our true worship is offering our bodies "as a living sacrifice..." In what ways could your worship be more "sacrificial?"
