1 Thursday ~ Weight of the Wait

One day at rock climbing a woman who was joining for the first time saw my local friend's cross necklace and was curious about why he was wearing it. "So were you always a follower of Jesus or did you convert later?" she asked. "I converted later," he answered, "Jesus came to me & everything in my life changed." This woman smiled and nodded, as if knowingly. "It's true," she said, "You never know when Jesus is going to show up or what he is going to do!"

4 Sunday ~ Heidi Lundgren

My friend and I were shocked that even though this woman is not yet a follower, she was completely expectant that Jesus would show up in someone's life and change everything. It's encouraging to see this kind of faith and expectancy among those who don't yet know him!

5 Monday ~ Heidi Lundgren

A sweet Russian friend has been joining us for climbing, and it has been cool to see how her interest in Jesus is growing. She said that even though she was raised as a "Christian," she's never really had the chance to read the Bible, so anytime we read a short passage and discuss it during our climbing day, she ends up reading much more of the passage in Russian.

6 Tuesday ~ Heidi Lundgren

She shared that when she was growing up in Russia she always thought that Jesus was harsh and strict, the type that pushes and drives people to try to be better. She said, "As I started to read, I see that that's not at all who he is! He's very likable!"

Vernon McGee who began teaching on the radio in a similar format in the Los Angeles area in 1967. People listen not only because the Bible is a good story and Dr. McGee is a good storyteller, but because the Bible is also the primary way God draws us to Himself.

13 Tuesday ~ Thru the Bible

Each weekday Thru the Bible is heard around the globe in over 120 languages and dialects. Thru the Bible's internet location gives a daily schedule of which scriptures will be covered. Most of June will be in the book of Job. Thru the Bible is available on the internet at any time by going to ttb.org and entering.

Our digital responders were in contact with over 5,000 Arabs seeking to know more about the Christian faith, and sixty-three people were involved in an online group studying God's word.

18 Sunday ~ Pioneers USA

Ask God to provide relationships & resources for Pioneers in Peru seeking to access and plant churches among some of the most unreached tribal groups in the world.

19 Monday ~ Pioneers USA

A Pioneer in drought-stricken East Africa asks us to pray for the poor and suffering. In the midst of many struggles, may they also thirst for and find living water.

20 Tuesday ~ Pioneers USA

Pioneers in Europe ask us to pray for the church they help lead to grow and become more like a family, a family others would want to join.

21 Wednesday ~ Pioneers USA

Father, we lift your name high over the nations of Turkey and Syria. We ask you to show your mighty hand. Comfort, protect and provide. Give wisdom and strength to those who are rescuing and serving. Unite your church to love and serve well. Reveal your goodness and glorify your name. Amen.

During the last 50 years, God has caused the Chinese church to explode, multiplying at least 80-100 times. Yet there have been minimal opportunities for leadership to be trained. It is that lack of trained leadership that burdens us. It was a vision to see the church in Taiwan begin to get a burden for Chinese around the world that took us there in 1995.

Debbie also teaches future pastors and church leaders at Central Taiwan CB Seminary in Hsilo, teaching Bible, Hebrew, Greek and missions. Peter also serves as field leader. In all our ministry, our goal is to live out 2 Timothy 2:2, "And the things you have heard me say in the presence of many witnesses entrust to reliable men who will also be qualified to teach others."
