## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{1}$ During those days another large crowd gathered. Since they had nothing to eat, Jesus called his disciples to him and said,

## Mark 8:1-26

2 "I have compassion for these people; they have already been with me three days and have nothing to eat.

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{3}$ If I send them home hungry, they will collapse on the way, because some of them have come a long distance."

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{4}$ His disciples answered, "But where in this remote place can anyone get enough bread to feed them?"

## Mark 8:1-26

5 "How many loaves do you have?" Jesus asked. "Seven," they replied. ${ }^{6} \mathrm{He}$ told the crowd to sit down on the ground.

## Mark 8:1-26

When he had taken the seven loaves and given thanks, he broke them and gave them to his disciples to distribute to the people, and they did so.

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{7}$ They had a few small fish as well; he gave thanks for them also and told the disciples to distribute them.

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{8}$ The people ate and were satisfied. Afterward the disciples picked up seven basketfuls of broken pieces that were left over.

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{9}$ About four thousand were present. After he had sent them away, ${ }^{10}$ he got into the boat with his disciples and went to the region of Dalmanutha.

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{11}$ The Pharisees came and began
to question Jesus. To test him, they asked him for a sign from heaven.

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{12} \mathrm{He}$ sighed deeply and said, "Why does this generation ask for a sign? Truly I tell you, no sign will be given to it."

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{13}$ Then he left them, got back into the boat and crossed to the other side. ${ }^{14}$ The disciples had forgotten to bring bread, except for one loaf they had with them in the boat.

## Mark 8:1-26

15 "Be careful," Jesus warned them. "Watch out for the yeast of the Pharisees and that of Herod."

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{16}$ They discussed this with one another and said, "It is because we have no bread."

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{17}$ Aware of their discussion, Jesus asked them: "Why are you talking about having no bread?

## Do you still not see or understand?

Are your hearts hardened?

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{18}$ Do you have eyes but fail to see, and ears but fail to hear? And don't you remember?

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{19}$ When I broke the five loaves
for the five thousand, how many basketfuls
of pieces did you pick up?" "Twelve," they replied.

## Mark 8:1-26

20 "And when I broke the seven loaves
for the four thousand, how many basketfuls
of pieces did you pick up?"
They answered, "Seven."

## Mark 8:1-26

## ${ }^{21}$ He said to them, "Do you still not understand?"

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{22}$ They came to Bethsaida, and some people brought a blind man and begged Jesus to touch him. ${ }^{23} \mathrm{He}$ took the blind man by the hand and led him outside the village.

## Mark 8:1-26

When he had spit on the man's eyes and put his hands on him, Jesus asked, "Do you see anything?" ${ }^{24} \mathrm{He}$ looked up and said, "I see people; they look like trees walking around."

## Mark 8:1-26

${ }^{25}$ Once more Jesus put his hands on the man's eyes.
Then his eyes were opened, his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly. ${ }^{26}$ Jesus sent him home, saying, "Don't even go into the village."
