- 4. When have you found yourself looking to Jesus as a means to some other end? When have you looked to Jesus as an end in and of Himself? What difference did it make?
- 5. What aspiration are you currently pursuing that you feel Jesus is calling you to surrender?
- 6. What aspiration do you currently believe Jesus is calling you to take up and pursue?
