4. When have you found yourself looking to Jesus as a means to some other end? When have you looked to Jesus as an end in and of Himself? What difference did it make?
5. What aspiration are you currently pursuing that you feel Jesus is calling you to surrender?
6. What aspiration do you currently believe Jesus is calling you to take up and pursue?
