Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Mark 10:46-52

- 1. How would you describe your journey with Jesus to this point in your life? Have you cried out to Him only once or many times? Did you need to decide to follow Him only once or does it seem to be more ongoing? Why do you think that is?
- 2. In what areas of your life do you often consider how Jesus relates to them? In what areas of your life do you almost never consider how Jesus relates to them? (Career, family, leisure, parenting, marriage, friends, retirement, health, entertainment, purchases, etc.)
- 3. What makes the difference? Why is following Him obvious in some areas but not others? Is there any area of life that we shouldn't surrender or bring into alignment with Jesus?
- 4. What is one "darkness" currently entangling you? How long has it lasted?
- 5. What hope do we have that Jesus will eventually end every type of darkness? How have you found that hope in the past when you were in despair?
- 6. When has Jesus' past faithfulness informed your trust of continuing to follow Him in the present—even if it was difficult or costly?
