Colossians 3:1-15

1. Where do you see your peers, neighbors, and colleagues place their hope? Do you notice a difference between Christians and non-Christians?
2. What "hopes" does your heart tend to gravitate toward? What do you find yourself daydreaming about when you aren't busy? What is the "that" that you believe will fulfill you if you had it?
3. How can we tell if we are placing our hope in things of this world versus simply enjoying them?
4. Have you ever felt hopeless? What helped to bring you out of that season?
5. Is placing hope in Christ more so natural or challenging for you? Why do you think that is? Does it vary with circumstances?
6. Is hoping in the future new heavens and new earth just a form of escapism? Why or why not?
