Questions for Reflection and Discussion

Genesis 2:18-25

3. How has Bridges provided relational connections for you? How could Bridges improve?
4. If you are married, what would you tell a single person about the relational connectedness within marriage? Does marriage meet all of your relational needs? Why or why not?
5. If you are a single person, what do you want married people to know about what it is like to be single in the church?
6. Discuss the idea of "God being enough to satisfy us" versus God's declaration that it was not good for man to be alone even when man had unrestricted access to God.
7. In what ways have you experienced Jesus meeting your relational needs when other people fell short?
