1 Corinthians 16

¹ Now concerning the collection for the saints:
as I directed the churches of Galatia,
so you also are to do.

1 Corinthians 16

² On the first day of every week, each of you is to put something aside and store it up, as he may prosper, so that there will be no collecting when I come.

1 Corinthians 16

³ And when I arrive, I will send those whom you accredit by letter to carry your gift to Jerusalem.

⁴ If it seems advisable that I should go also, they will accompany me.

1 Corinthians 16

⁵ I will visit you after passing through Macedonia, for I intend to pass through Macedonia, ⁶ and perhaps I will stay with you or even spend the winter, so that you may help me on my journey, wherever I go.

1 Corinthians 16

⁷ For I do not want to see you now just in passing.
I hope to spend some time with you,
if the Lord permits.

1 Corinthians 16

⁸ But I will stay in Ephesus until Pentecost,
⁹ for a wide door for effective work has opened
to me, and there are many adversaries.

1 Corinthians 16

¹⁰ When Timothy comes, see that you put him at ease among you, for he is doing the work of the Lord, as I am.

1 Corinthians 16

¹¹ So let no one despise him. Help him on his way in peace, that he may return to me, for I am expecting him with the brothers.

1 Corinthians 16

¹² Now concerning our brother Apollos, I strongly urged him to visit you with the other brothers, but it was not at all his will to come now. He will come when he has opportunity.

1 Corinthians 16

¹³ Be watchful, stand firm in the faith, act like men, be strong. ¹⁴ Let all that you do be done in love.

1 Corinthians 16

¹⁵ Now I urge you, brothers—
you know that the household of Stephanas
were the first converts in Achaia,

1 Corinthians 16

and that they have devoted themselves to the service of the saints— ¹⁶ be subject to such as these, and to every fellow worker and laborer.

1 Corinthians 16

¹⁷ I rejoice at the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus, because they have made up for your absence, ¹⁸ for they refreshed my spirit as well as yours. Give recognition to such people.

¹⁹ The churches of Asia send you greetings. Aquila and Prisca, together with the church in their house, send you hearty greetings in the Lord.

Greet one another with a holy kiss.
