Questions for Reflection and Discussion

John 13:12-17, 31-35

- 1. Do you find it hard to love or serve people you view as undeserving? What are some excuses you make?

- 3. Describe the significance of the words "just as" to the Christian life (v. 15).
- 4. What is God's glory (vv. 31-32)? What does it mean to live for God's glory, and how does our loving one another give God glory?
- 5. How can Jesus call the command to love one another a "new" command, since it is also mentioned often in the Old Testament?
- 6. What is the difference between love as a feeling and love that acts?
- 7. Do you feel that love for others is a valid test for whether or not a person is a genuine Christian? Why or why not?
- 8. How is humble service a picture of the gospel to an unbelieving world?
