Questions for Reflection and Discussion Luke 24:1-12

- 1. When have you needed to bear a cost in order to restore someone or something from brokenness? Examples: healing organizational or relational dysfunction, rebuilding homes after a disaster, cleansing a corrupt system, etc.

- 6. What are ways that we act/feel/think as if it isn't true?
- 7. What might change about the world if Christians always behaved and interacted with others with total confidence in our perfect future?
