Questions for Reflection and Discussion

John 1:1-5

1. The Father glorifies the Son, the Son glorifies the Father, and the Spirit glorifies the Father and Son. What does this "others-focused" love within the Trinity reveal about what love is?
2. We sometimes think of love primarily in terms of how the other person makes me feel. How is biblical love different when we understand it as seeking the good and glory of another person?
3. Where do you see the tendency to make yourself the center—in your relationships, family, work, church, or even your relationship with God? What might it look like to become more "others-focused" this week?
4. When do you find it hardest to genuinely celebrate someone else's success, honor, or recognition? What does that reveal about your heart?
5. If there is no darkness, death, evil, or decay in God, what does that tell us about the things Jesus came to undo through His miracles?
6. Where have you experienced Jesus bringing light or life into something that once felt dark or dead?
7. If God is eternally loving, life-giving, and full of light—and Jesus came to bring us back into that life—what part of your life most needs to be brought into His light and life right now?
8. What would be different in your life if you really believed that the deepest reality in the universe is not darkness or death, but the love and life of God?
